WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Sourced from a single vineyard site on the banks of the Awatere River. The grapes were harvested in the early hours of the morning to retain crisp varietal character. The grapes were gently pressed and fermented at cool temperatures to accentuate the pure aromatics of this varietal.

DESCRIPTION

Pungent red capsicum, white current and fresh herbs on the nose with hints of lime peel and pea pod. The palate is bursting with ripe juicy acidity matched with tropical fruit, finishing with a salty mineral edge.
