

2014 Sparkling Rosé Marlborough, New Zealand

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Sourced from a single vineyard in the new sub region of Ward Valley, in Southern Marlborough. Grown in deep clay loam soils with traces of limestone. Picked at dawn by hand to retain freshness and acidity from a special parcel of the Pinot Noir clone Abel. The grapes were gently de-stemmed and lightly pressed before the free run wine was fermented and left on the lees for 11 months before bottling.

DESCRIPTION

A vivacious sparkling rose with an abundance of strawberry and cranberry aromas and nuances of rose petal and orange blossom. Made with 100% Pinot Noir grapes, it exudes red fruit flavours and finishes with a slight sweet spice. Best enjoyed during celebration.
