WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The 2015 vintage was fantastic from a quality, but challenging from a volume perspective. To make this year's wine we've blended fruit from our Ward Valley vineyard in Marlborough with a superb parcel from Waipara to create a wonderfully balanced wine. Partially handpicked and hand sorted, the grapes were then gently de-stemmed and then fermented in small open top cuvees and hand plunged 4 times per day. Very gently pressed, the wine was aged with French oak for 4 months prior to light filtration before bottling.
