WINEMAKER'S NOTES

An fantastic blend of 91% Sauvignon Blanc, 6% Pinot Noir Rose and 3% Pinot Noir. The Sauvignon Blanc gives beautiful lifted aromatics while the Pinot Noir gives it the lovely blush colour and softens the palate.

Grapes were sourced from both the Awatere and Wairau valleys in Marlborough, being harvested in the early hours of the morning to retain crisp varietal character. Overall two tropical storms, Debbie in late March and Cook in mid April, made this a very challenging year for Marlborough.

The wine is crisp and dry, making it a lovely aperitif.

DESCRIPTION

A delightfully expressed rosé, the beautifully lifted bouquet shows raspberry, green rockmelon, passionfruit and lime zest characters.
