WINEMAKER'S NOTES

An incredibly hot vintage with low tonnage. 2015 was picked exceptionally early in mid March. A blend of Awatere and Wairau fruit gives this wine a backbone of minerality with plenty of tropical characteristics. The grapes were gently pressed and fermented at cool temperatures to accentuate the pure aromatics.
